I can appreciate that some of you again may have some concerns about your children's safety at this time. It is extremely important that children are in school, especially with this lockdown happening so close to the beginning of the year.

The Ministry has provided schools with clear expectations of what systems and procedures we need to have in place during this period to keep our children safe and I would personally like to reassure you that our school is taking these guidelines extremely seriously and we are ready for all children to attend. - Mufti can be paid via kindo, or coins will be accepted on the hall deck on the day




