We will now be separating out the PTA newsletter from the school newsletter. Please look out for this during the week.







# What is a Walking School Bus?

A walking school bus (WSB) is just like a school bus except children walk to and from school under the supervision of adult volunteers (often parents). This creates a safe and social journey to school.

### **Benefits for parents**

- "More than anything, the WSB gives me time with my kids that I might miss
  by dropping them in the car...and I get to know other families that live in my
  community."
- "This is so much easier than taking the car... I don't have to find a park!"
- "What a great way to teach the kids about Road Safety."
- "I really look forward to my day on the WSB; I have met so many nice families in my neighbourhood."
- "You can have young children that you might not send off by themselves, but they can join the walking school bus."
- "I want my kids to walk; I want them to get to school having had a bit of exercise."
- "For me it was a social thing and I wanted to know who my kids were hanging out with."
