We have considered the safety of our students, staff and whānau and we have made the decision to close our school on Monday.

This means that Botany Downs School will not be open for onsite learning on Monday 13 February.

We will review the situation on Monday lunchtime based on further weather updates and assess the safety of our school for our students, staff and whānau. We will send the decision about school opening on Tuesday, in the early afternoon.
